- **Vice Chair Report:** None
- **RCM reports:**
Fred brought copies of his report and the RCM II. Jodie asked that she be funded \$65.00 to go to the RSC in May in South San Antonio and that the Travel Check be given to Ian. The travel check was issued and given to Ian. Fred passed out copies of the proposed new index for the Basic Text and needs input back from the groups ASAP. Next RSC will be May 10 in South San Antonio. As of a couple of weeks ago Hill Country Area was the only area that had turned in their CAR votes (way to go Groups) Agape group has asked for a workshop on "How to Chair a Meeting". To date we have not received any minutes from the February RSC.
- **Treasurer's Report:** Ledger Balance: \$2,286.36. See Report at end of minutes. Larry states that the Signa bill is due. There is an extra charge for 79 phone calls. Fred will call to find out what the extra charge is all about. See report summary at the end of these minutes.
- **Public Information:** No report as this position is vacant.

- **Web Servant Report:** Bob T said that the web page is doing well. Again he is requesting articles on recovery in NA.
