As last year, my daughter is participating the annual fishing trip for the disabled, which is sponsored by the Hole in the Wall Foundation in Port Aransas. I would like to thank Steve for handling the treasury responsibilities this month. I have prepared all the reports that Steve will be giving you in my absence.

The current status of our books now:

The bank statement balances with the check book register this month. The ending bank statement balance is **\$2610.89**

The ending register balance is **\$ 478.36**, which takes into account for 5 outstanding checks in the amount of **\$2132.53**

We have **\$5.00** cash on hand in the petty cash fund (change)

The ledger balance is **\$478.36**

The register report page will show you the deposit from last month, when it was made, and the checks that were written during the month.

The itemized income/expense page (6) show exactly what we spent money on last month, and details the money that came in. The available money to spend is **\$-13.69**, however there is actually **\$478.36** in the bank, and we will have donations from groups today so that the balance is sure to increase next month.

Finally the last page (7) is the details of the group donations current to this date.
